What is Accent?

- Accent is a combination of 3 main components:
 - Intonation *speech music*
 - Liaisons word connections
 - Pronunciation spoken sounds of vowels, consonants, and combinations



"u" Sound



• The lips are somewhat rounded, and the muscles of the mouth are relaxed.

This is a short sound.

"u" sound as in Book.



Aspirated Sounds



Some of the aspirated sounds are:

P as in Process

K as in Kodak

C as in Customer

T as in Technical

Q as in Quiet

Alabama	Plant	Advantage	After	Demand


